Subject: Year 2007 Training Schedule

Our schedule of training sessions for 2007 is set. We will offer five seminars at various times and locations. The five seminars are:

- **Basic Sales and Service Training** – 3 days
- **Basic Service Training** – 2 or 3 days depending on location
- **Advanced Service Training** – 3 days
- **AUMATIC Programming Seminar** – 1 day
- **AUMATIC Service Training** – 2 ½ days

Basic Sales and Service Training is intended for new representatives, distributors or automation centers and new people at existing organizations. The program is also suitable for OEM/resale customers. Topics include actuation requirements, AUMA products, theory of actuator operation, actuator selection & pricing, actuator commissioning and troubleshooting.

Basic Service Training is intended for sales and service personnel from representatives, distributors, automation centers and customers. Topics include theory of actuator operation, actuator commissioning and troubleshooting. Class size is limited to 20 students.

Advanced Service Training is intended for the service technician who will be repairing and commissioning AUMA Actuators. **A prerequisite of attending the advanced class is either prior experience servicing / commissioning AUMA actuators or prior attendance at the Basic Service Training class.** The class is hands-on troubleshooting, service and repair. Product basic information and identification are not covered. **Class size will be limited to a maximum of 10 students.**

The **AUMATIC Programming Seminar** is intended for sales personnel who want a better understanding of the AUMATIC capabilities. The session includes theory and programming. This seminar will be offered on the day following each of the scheduled Basic Sales and Service Training seminars. **Class size is limited to 10 students.**

AUMATIC Service Training is intended for service technicians who will be repairing and commissioning AUMATICs. Topics will include AUMATIC details, the MWG, COM-AC software, board identification, troubleshooting and diagnostics. **Class size is limited to 10 students.**

Locations:

Seminars in Pittsburgh will be held at AUMA’s factory in Canonsburg, PA. The facility is located at 100 Southpointe Blvd. and is 21 miles south of Pittsburgh and 25 miles from the Pittsburgh International Airport.

Seminars in Tustin will be held at AUMA’s office. The facility includes a large training room and is located at 15012 Red Hill Ave.

All class times start at 9:00 AM unless otherwise stated.

Seminar fees:

The fee for all seminars is \$200 per attendee. Fees are due with reservation and are non-refundable. AUMA furnishes training materials, lunch and dinner at local restaurants on the evenings of class days – except for the last day of the seminar. **Attendees are responsible for their own transportation and lodging.**
